Dear Trinity Travelers,

We are once again on the cusp of summer; a season of bare feet and short sleeves, of lemonade and picnics. It is the season when campgrounds, gift shops and lodges in national parks across the country prepare for new summer visitors. Summer is also the season when ACMNP ministry volunteers travel to one of 25 national parks for a summer of life-changing ministry.

As we head into our 57th season, ACMNP requests your financial assistance for three very important reasons:

1. In an effort to generate fund-raising energy, one of our major donors has issued a challenge for us to raise \$40,000 from new donors. Once we do so, we will be awarded an additional \$20,000 from this donor. We are currently half-way to our goal, which must be met by August 31, 2008.
